Text format: Microsoft Word (.doc, .docx files). 4. Text language: Ukrainian, English. 5. Page orientation: portrait only. 6. Font: Times New Roman, size 14. 7. Line spacing - 1, paragraph - 1.25 cm. 8. Text colour: black. 9. All margins (top, bottom, left, right): 2 cm. 10. At the abstract's beginning, the research direction is indicated in the upper left corner. 11. Article title (size 14, capital letters, bold, centre alignment). 12. Author's full name(s) (font size 14, bold, right alignment); academic degree, academic title, position (font: Times New Roman, size 14); workplace or education place (font: Times New Roman, size 14); e-mail of the abstract author(s) (font: Times New Roman, size 14). 13. The article's main text (font size 14, line spacing - 1, paragraph indentation - 1.25 cm, width alignment). 14. List of references: formed at the end of the abstract, sign 'List of references'.

Materials from representatives of sanctioned countries and occupied territories are not accepted.

The presentation must contain the topic, main ideas of the author(s) and conclusions. After a preliminary review of the accepted presentations, the authors will be invited to submit full articles to the international scientific journal Military Science (themilitaryscience.com). Original author's publications that have not been previously presented in other periodicals are accepted for consideration.
